
Bridgeton minister charged with aggravated sex assault

BRIDGETON — The Rev. Terry Duran Dixon of the Miracle Survival Center has been charged with two counts of aggravated sexual assault, Detective Charles Leyman of the Bridgeton Police Department said.

According to Leyman, police received a call from South Jersey Hospital-Bridgeton on Sunday morning that a victim was being treated there for sexual assault.

Leyman said he went to the hospital, interviewed

the 19-year-old woman, and found that she went to Dixon's house Sunday and was assaulted in the basement.

Police then arrested Dixon and charged him with one count

of aggravated sexual assault.

During the ensuing investigation, other women have come forward, including one who said she had sex with Dixon while she was a minor, Leyman said.

An additional charge of aggravated sexual assault was filed against Dixon on Monday as a result of the interview with the second woman, Leyman said.

Dixon is being held in the Cumberland County Jail on \$50,000 cash bail.

The investigation is ongoing, Leyman said.
