Dear Father Higgins:

I have been contacted by [REDACTED] who is a resident [REDACTED] [REDACTED] indicates that he contacted you and other representatives of the Archdiocese in 1999 with reference to the conduct of Father James J. Foley who was assigned to Holy Name Church in West Roxbury from the early 1980s through the early 1990s. [REDACTED] was an altar boy and also worked in the office at the Holy Name Rectory from approximately 1983 to 1986. At the time [REDACTED] worked at the Rectory, he was 13 years of age and his employment at the Rectory ended when he was approximately 16. During the period that [REDACTED] worked at the Holy Name Rectory, he was sexually assaulted by Father Foley and reported this to you several years ago.

[REDACTED] is not interested, at the present time, in pursuing a civil action against Father Foley or the Archdiocese. He does, however, wish to have information



concerning the disposition of this matter and a summary of any treatment that Father Foley has had and/or disciplinary action imposed by the Archdiocese on Father Foley since he reported this incident. Also, [REDACTED] would like to be informed of the names of any other persons who were similarly assaulted by Father Foley during his tenure at Holy Name Parish.

I understand that some months ago [REDACTED] again corresponded with you and was informed that he would be receiving a letter from the Archdiocese outlining the disposition of this matter with an apology from the Archdiocese. I know that you are busy with other matters at the present time, however, this unresolved issue is important to us and we would like to have it addressed immediately. I would expect your response to this letter by June 15th, 2002, and appreciate your prompt attention to this matter.
