Priest refuses to testify

A former parish priest convicted of child molestation refused to testify in a civil case against the Catholic Diocese of Stockton.

Superior Court Judge Bob McNatt held the Rev. Oliver O'Grady in contempt of court Tuesday. Although

McNatt could send O'Grady to jail for refusing to testify, that would be insignificant since the priest already is doing time in prison for child molestation.

The Stockton Diocese and its leadership are being accused of allowing O'Grady to work in church even though they knew he was a pedophile.
