Thirty-Three New Jesuits To Be Ordained June 13

Thirty-three Jesuits will be ordained to the sacred priesthood at St. Mary's Cathedral, San Francisco, by Archbishop John J. Mitty on Thursday, June 13.

Seventeen will be ordained for the California Province of the Society; 14 for Oregon; one for Chicago, and one for Mexico. Two others, originally sched-

uled for ordination with the group, will be raised to the priestly office Saturday, June 8, in Zikawei, China. They are Fr. John Brennan, S.J. and Fr. John Donahue, S.J.

Local Priests in Group

Two of the new priests are Southern Californians and will celebrate their first Solemn Masses in churches of this Archdiocese.

Fr. C. Edward Crews, S.J., 31, will sing his first Mass on Sunday, June 23, at St. Charles Borromeo Church, North Hollywood. The son of Mr. and Mrs. Clarence S. Crews of 10614 Riverside Dr., North Hollywood, he was educated locally at Star of the Sea parish school, San Pedro, and Loyola High. Fr. Crews taught at the latter school for five years.

One week later, Fr. Alexander R. Tait, S.J., 31, of Huntington Park, will celebrate his first Solemn Mass at St. Matthias Church. He is a graduate of St. Matthias parish school and Cathedral High here. His parents are Mr. and Mrs. A. J. Rosbottom of 6229 Albany St., Huntington Park.

Fr. Robert Andrew Rosenfelder, S.J., 30, of Toledo, O., will celebrate his first Solemn Mass at St. Anselm's Church here, on Sunday, June 23.
