The Rev. George W. Moore, 64, pastor of St. Malachy's Roman Catholic Church in Manhattan, commonly known as "the actors' chapel," died Friday at Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center in Manhattan. He died of prostate cancer, which had been in remission for eight years, a spokeswoman for the church said. The church was made famous as the locale of the movie Going My Way, starring Bing Crosby and Ingrid Bergman.
