Pastor of Our Lady of the Valley Catholic Church in Canoga Park, California, for 33 years, from 1943 to 1976. During his long pastorate, the parish church was rebuilt twice, the last time being in 1969 when the new school was also built. From his obituary in the Los Angeles Times, Jan. 11, 1995:

"HURLEY, Reverend Monsignor John, age 91, of Canoga Park. Passed away January 7, 1995. Born December 4, 1903 at Donoughmore, Ireland. Pastor Emeritus of Our Lady of the Valley Church in Canoga Park. Monsignor Hurley was ordained in 1928 and came directly to Los Angeles where he served in many parishes, including St. Brendan's, St. Vibiana Cathedral, and St. Andrew's in Pasadena. His first assignment as pastor was at Holy Family Church in Artesia, and in 1943 he came to Our Lady of the Valley parish in Canoga Park, retiring in 1976. He leaves behind a distinguished record of ministry, and thousands of people who will never forget their pastor, Fr. Hurley. May he rest in peace. ...Mass of Christian Burial Thursday, January 12, 11 a.m., at St. Joseph the Worker Church, Canoga Park (Our Lady of the Valley was still undergoing repairs from the 1994 Earthquake). Interment will follow at San Fernando Mission Cemetery."
