

# NOTICE TO THE CHRISTIAN FAITHFUL OF THE DIOCESE OF SCRANTON

**Mr. Gregory Francis Loughney**, formerly an incardinated priest of the Diocese of Scranton, has been dispensed from the clerical state, effective February 29, 2024.

Mr. Loughney submitted a petition to the Most Holy Father, Pope Francis, requesting dispensation from the clerical state, which has been granted and is final.

Loughney is no longer a member of the clergy, nor has any of the privileges or responsibilities of the priesthood. A priest who has been dispensed from the clerical state may not celebrate Mass or confer the Sacraments. He may no longer be called "Father" or wear clerical attire.

Mr. Loughney now lives privately and is no longer affiliated with the Diocese of Scranton in any official capacity.

El Sr. Gregory Francis Loughney, ex sacerdote incardinado de la Diócesis de Scranton, ha sido dispensado del estado clerical a partir del 29 de febrero de 2024.

El Sr. Loughney presentó una petición al Santo Padre, el Papa Francisco, solicitando la dispensa del estado clerical, la cual ha sido concedida y es definitiva.

Loughney ya no es miembro del clero ni tiene ninguno de los privilegios o responsabilidades del sacerdocio. Un sacerdote dispensado del estado clerical no podrá celebrar Misa ni conferir los Sacramentos. Ya no se debera llamar "Padre". Ni debe usar vestimenta clerical.

El Sr. Loughney ahora vive en forma privada y ya no está afiliado a la Diócesis de Scranton en ninguna capacidad oficial.
