Immaculate Conception Parochial School (ICPS) started when the **Holy Name Society** and the **Catholic Women's League (CWL)** under the leadership of the Parish Priest of Immaculate Conception Parish, **Msgr. Florentino C. Fuentes, P.H.**, conceived of founding a school whose aim was to help the low and middle-income groups avail of a quality Catholic Education.

*The School was named after the Patroness of the **Immaculate Conception Parish**.*

**June 2, 1975**

The Grade School Department was granted **Government Recognition (No.78, s.1975)**

**1981**

**Rt. Rev. Msgr. Antero A. Sarmiento, P.H.**, became the Parish Priest and School Director. Msgr. **Sarmiento** spearheaded the building of the three-storey edifice which housed the intermediate grades.

**1986**

**Msgr. Sarmiento** sought the permission of His Eminence, **Jamie Cardinal Sin, D.D.**, to expand ICPS by putting up a High School Department. The school's benefactor, the **Catholic Women's League (CWL)** started fund-raising projects to support the construction of the four-storey high school building.

**1987**

The High School Department was formally opened during the school year **1987-1988**
