

City Born Man Marks 25 Years As Priest

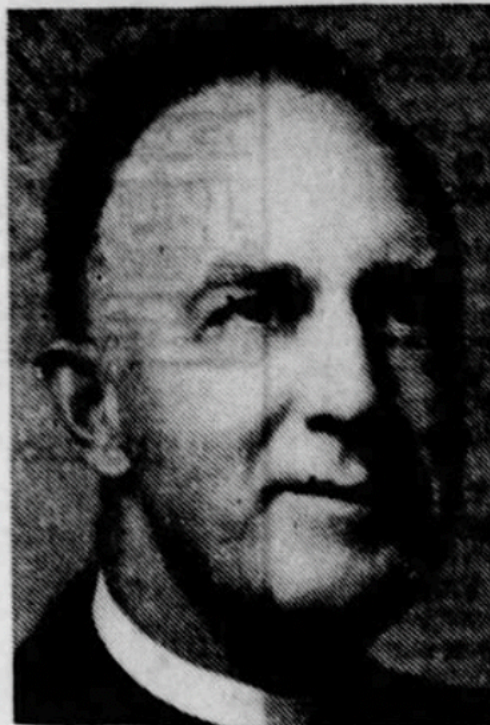
The silver sacerdotal jubilee of the Rev. Albert V. Deery, pastor of St. Augustine' Church at Jeffersonville and a former Indianapolis resident, will be celebrated with a solemn high mass of thanksgiving at 10:30 o'clock tomorrow morning.

The Most Reverend Joseph E. Ritter, archbishop of Indianapolis, will deliver the sermon and the Rev. Paul J. Utz, assistant pastor of St. Augustine's Church, will be master of ceremony.

Assisting in the service will be the Rev. Mr. Deery's brother, Msgr. Paul A. Deery of the Old Cathedral at Vincennes; his cousin, the Rev. Michael Keene of St. Meinrad Abbey; the Rev. James J. Maloney of Holy Cross Church at Louisville, Ky., and the Rt. Rev. James A. Downey.

The Rev. Mr. Deery, a native of Indianapolis, is the son of the late Mr. and Mrs. John A. Deery, pioneer residents of the city and charter members of St. Joseph's Church. A sister, Mrs. Mary E. Deery, and brother, John A. Deery, both live here.

Seminary. He served first at St. Catherine of Sienna Church here, began the first Catholic Scout troop here in 1924, served at Bloomington, later was appointed to St. Joseph's Church here in 1932 and in 1942 was installed pastor of St. Augustine Church by Archbishop Ritter.
