

Marvin J. Kapushion To Be Ordained As Priest Here Friday

Joseph's Catholic Church here. Father Kapushion will say his first solemn mass June 10 in St. Joseph's Church.

Father Kapushion was born April 18, 1930, in Crested Butte and came to Grand Junction in September, 1944. He was graduated from Grand Junction High School in 1948. While a student there, he was a member of Quill and Scroll, Thespians, Latin Club, Ski Club and Anthos Club. He was graduated among the top 10 of his class. At the end of his junior year, he was awarded a five-week summer scholarship in dramatics to Denver University.

Father Kapushion entered St. Thomas Seminary in September, 1948. He finished four years of college there and was awarded his BA degree in philosophy there in 1952. He entered the school of theology in September, 1952, and completed his course May 26 of this year.

During the past three summers, Father Kapushion has been an instructor in the academic school at the State Home and Training School here.
