

PASTOR TO MARK SILVER JUBILEE AS CATHOLIC PRIEST

jubilee of his ordination to the Roman Catholic priesthood with a solemn mass at noon next Sunday in St. Joseph church, East Chicago, Ind. Bishop Andrew G. Gautka, of the Gary Diocese,

will preside. A reception and testimonial dinner in the church hall will follow the services.

Father Buczyna, son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Adelbert Buczyna, was born in 1908 in what is now known as Chicago's back of the yards district. He attended Sacred Heart grammar school, St. Mary's high school, Orchard Lake, Mich. and was graduated from Weber High school, 5252 Palmer st. Father Buczyna took his bachelor of arts degree in 1932 from St. Mary's college, Orchard Lake. His theological studies were completed in SS. Cyril and Methodius seminary, Orchard Lake, and St. Meinard [Ind.] seminary. He was ordained June 6, 1936 in the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception, Fort Wayne, Ind.

The cleric served as an assistant pastor of St. Stanislaus church, East Chicago, Ind. for thirteen years, then was pastor of Immaculate Conception church, La Otto, Ind. from 1949 until 1953 when he was made pastor of St. Joseph parish.
