

Assistant Named at St. Paul's

The Rev. Samuel T. Curry, a 26-year-old Indianapolis native, has assumed his duties as assistant pastor at St. Paul's Catholic Church.

The Rev. Curry, who succeeded the Rev. Charles Lahey, who was transferred to Holy Name Parish, Indianapolis, is a graduate of the Latin School of Indianapolis High School.

Following graduation he attended Mary's College near Bardstown, where he received his degree in philosophy.

He studied four years at St. Maur's, a catholic seminary in Indianapolis and was ordained into the priesthood June 6 this year in his native city. His first Mass was celebrated June 13 at St. Patrick's, Indianapolis.

For the past three years he has taught school including a year each at St. Patrick's Elementary School, Cathedral High School and Cardinal Ritter High School, all in Indianapolis.

The assistantship at St. Paul's is Father Curry's first assignment.
