

Rev. Louis A. Jeziorski

Rev. Louis A. Jeziorski, 70, of 903 Old Lincoln Hwy., Schererville, Ind., died at 4:15 a.m. Friday in St. Catherine's Hospital in East Chicago after an extended illness. He was born Sept. 29, 1902, in South Bend, and was the son of the late Stephen and Hattie Jeziorski. Surviving are a brother, Matt of South Bend; three sisters, Miss Angeline Jeziorski of Michigan City, Mrs. Yolanda Glon and Mrs. Carrie Koleziak, both of South Bend. He attended St. Adalbert's grade school, then entered the S. S. Cyril-Methodius High School in Orchard Lake, Mich., in 1927, and graduated from there in 1931. In 1933, he entered St. Meinard Seminary in Meinard, Ind. On May 19, 1940, he was ordained to the priesthood in the Immaculate Conception Cathedral in Fort Wayne. Before his retirement in 1969, he served as pastor for 19 years at the All Saints parish in San Pierre, Ind.

Interment will be in the mausoleum in St. Joseph Cemetery in South Bend.
