

Rev. J. Shanahan

COLUMBUS, Ohio—The Rev. James Shanahan, 70, died Saturday, Nov. 14, 1992, at his home.

He was born in Rushville May 3, 1922, the son of the late William E. and Cecelia (Toolin) Shanahan. He was preceded in death by three brothers and two sisters.

He attended St. Mary Grade School and St. Meinrad Seminary. He was ordained a priest May 27, 1947.

His first assignment was assistant pastor of St. Paul Catholic Church in Tell City.

In 1956, he was assigned to St. Anne Catholic Church in New Castle, Ind.; 1960, pastor of St. Rose Catholic Church in Knightstown, Ind.; 1969, administrator of St. Anne Catholic Church, New Castle, Ind.; 1970, associate chaplain, St. Mary-of-the-Woods Convent, St. Mary-of-the-Woods, Ind.; 1971, administrator of St. Joseph Mission, Universal, Ind.; 1972, administrator protem of Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Clinton, Ind., and continuing as administrator of St. Joseph Mission in Universal; 1973, pastor of Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Clinton, and continued as administrator of St. Joseph Mission, Universal. He retired in 1986.

He was a member of the Knights of Columbus 4th Degree, Father Peters Assembly.

Surviving is a brother, Pete Shanahan of Columbus, Ohio; and several nieces and nephews.

A Mass of Resurrection was celebrated at 11 a.m. Thursday (today) at St. Mary Catholic Church in Rushville, Ind., with burial in Calvary Cemetery.
